- 7 (1) No vehicle shall be driven or moved on any public highway
- 8 unless such vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to prevent any of
- 9 its load from dropping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping
- 10 therefrom, except that sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing
- 11 traction. Any person operating a vehicle from which any glass or
- 12 objects have fallen or escaped, which would constitute an obstruction
- 13 or injure a vehicle or otherwise endanger travel upon such public
- 14 highway shall immediately cause the public highway to be cleaned of all
- 15 such glass or objects and shall pay any costs therefor.
- 16 (2) No person may operate on any public highway any vehicle with
- 17 any load unless the load and such covering as required thereon by
- 18 subsection (3) of this section is securely fastened to prevent the
- 19 covering or load from becoming loose, detached, or in any manner a
- 20 hazard to other users of the highway.
- 21 (3) Any vehicle operating on a paved public highway with a load of
- 22 dirt, sand, or gravel susceptible to being dropped, spilled, leaked, or
- 23 otherwise escaping therefrom shall be covered so as to prevent
- 24 spillage. Covering of such loads is not required if six inches of
- 25 freeboard is maintained within the bed.
- 26 (4) Any vehicle with deposits of mud, rocks, or other debris on the
- 27 vehicle's body, fenders, frame, undercarriage, wheels, or tires shall
- 28 be cleaned of such material before the operation of the vehicle on a
- 29 paved public highway.

- 1 (5) The state patrol may make necessary rules to carry into effect
- 2 the provisions of this section, applying such provisions to specific
- 3 conditions and loads and prescribing means, methods, and practices to
- 4 effectuate such provisions.
- 5 (6) Nothing in this section may be construed to prohibit a public
- 6 maintenance vehicle from dropping sand on a highway to enhance
- 7 traction, or sprinkling water or other substances to clean or maintain
- 8 a highway.
- 9 (7) This section does not apply to waste products falling from
- 10 <u>vehicles hauling live farm animals when crossing a ferry capable only</u>
- 11 of transporting fewer than twenty-five vehicles."
