- 6 to provide replacement funds for school construction at a time when the
- 7 traditional sources of funding are decreasing due to lower timber
- 8 harvesting."
- 9 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 5. A new section is added to chapter 82.32 RCW
- 10 to read as follows:
- 11 The department shall deposit into the common school construction
- 12 fund moneys collected under chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW in excess of
- 13 six million five hundred thousand dollars in any fiscal year from out-
- 14 of-state sellers on sales to persons or entities in this state through
