5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the creation  
8 of new jobs is crucial to the economic well-being of the state and its  
9 residents. As several commercial airlines are considering establishing  
10 major aircraft maintenance facilities in the state, it is important for  
11 the state to demonstrate the ability to provide a skilled work force  
12 with the technical skills essential for such a facility. Providing  
13 additional state assistance to vocational training programs on aircraft  
14 maintenance will ease job displacement in the state and offer an  
15 incentive for economic development."

16 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. From biennial appropriations to the work  
17 force training and education coordinating board for the job skills  
18 training program, the board shall allocate the sum of five hundred  
19 thousand dollars for the 1991-93 biennium and the sum of one million  
20 dollars for the 1993-95 biennium to a state technical or community  
21 college for the purpose of a vocational training program for the  
22 maintenance of commercial aircraft. The board shall allocate the  
23 moneys under this section only after the governor determines that a  
24 commercial airline will establish a new facility in this state for the  
25 maintenance of commercial aircraft. If no determination is made by  
26 January 1, 1993, or if the governor determines before January 1, 1993,  
27 that no facility will be established, this section has no effect and

1 the board may allocate these moneys for other purposes of the job  
2 skills training program."

3 "Sec. 3. RCW 28C.04.420 and 1983 1st ex. s. c 21 ú 4 are each  
4 amended to read as follows:

5 The commission may, subject to appropriation from the legislature  
6 or from funds made available from any other public or private source  
7 and pursuant to rules adopted by the commission, provide job skills  
8 grants to educational institutions. The job skills grants shall be  
9 used exclusively for programs which are consistent with the job skills  
10 program. A job skills grant may be awarded only after:

11 (1) Receipt of an application from an educational institution which  
12 contains a proposal for a program of skills training and education,  
13 including a description of the program, the type of skills training or  
14 education to be provided, a statement of the total cost of the program  
15 and a breakdown of the costs associated with equipment, personnel,  
16 facilities, and materials, a statement of the employment needs for the  
17 program and evidence in support thereof, demonstrates that the program  
18 does not unnecessarily duplicate existing programs in the area and is  
19 provided at a reasonable cost, a statement of the technical assistance  
20 and financial support for the program received or to be received from  
21 business and industry, and such other information as the commission  
22 requests; and

23 (2) The commission, based on the application submitted by the  
24 educational institution and such additional investigation as the staff  
25 of the commission shall make, finds that:

26 (a) The program is within the scope of the job skills program under  
27 this chapter and may reasonably be expected to succeed and thereby  
28 increase employment within the state;

1 (b) Provision has been made to use any available alternative  
2 funding from local, state, and federal sources;

3 (c) The job skills grant will only be used to cover the costs  
4 associated with the program;

5 (d) The program will not unnecessarily duplicate existing programs  
6 and could not be provided by another educational institution more  
7 effectively or efficiently;

8 (e) The program involves an area of skills training and education  
9 for which there is a demonstrable need;

10 (f) The applicant has made provisions for the use of existing  
11 federal and state resources for student financial assistance;

12 (g) The job skills grant is essential to the success of the program  
13 as the resources of the applicant are inadequate to attract the  
14 technical assistance and financial support necessary for the program  
15 from business and industry;

16 (h) The commitment of financial support from business and industry  
17 shall be equal to or greater than the amount of the requested job  
18 skills grant, except that no commitment is necessary for grants under  
19 section 2 of this act;

20 (i) Binding commitments have been made to the commission by the  
21 applicant for adequate reporting of information and data regarding the  
22 program to the commission, particularly information concerning the  
23 recruitment and employment of trainees and students, and including a  
24 requirement for an annual or other periodic audit of the books of the  
25 applicant directly related to the program, and for such control on the  
26 part of the commission as it considers prudent over the management of  
27 the program, so as to protect the use of public funds, including, in  
28 the discretion of the commission and without limitation, right of  
29 access to financial and other records of the applicant directly related  
30 to the programs;

1 (j) Provision has been made by the applicant to work, in  
2 cooperation with the employment security department, to identify and  
3 screen potential trainees and that provision has been made by the  
4 applicant of persons who are victims of economic dislocation and  
5 persons from minority and economically disadvantaged groups to  
6 participate in the program; and

7 (k) Binding commitments have been made to the commission by the  
8 applicant for compliance with the monitoring and evaluation rules of  
9 the commission."

10 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate  
11 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
12 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
13 effect immediately."

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17 In line 1 of the title, after "training;" strike the remainder of  
18 the title and insert "amending RCW 28C.04.420; creating new sections;  
19 and declaring an emergency."
