- 11 (1) It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully disobey the
- 12 order of the chief administrative officer of a public school district,
- 13 or of an authorized designee of any such administrator, to leave any
- 14 motor vehicle, building, grounds or other property which is owned,
- 15 operated or controlled by the school district or approved private
- 16 <u>school</u> if the person so ordered is under the influence of alcohol or
- 17 drugs, or is committing, threatens to imminently commit or incites
- 18 another to imminently commit any act which would disturb or interfere
- 19 with or obstruct any lawful task, function, process or procedure of the
- 20 school district or approved private school or any lawful task,
- 21 function, process or procedure of any student, official, employee or
- 22 invitee of the school district or approved private school. The order
- 23 of a school officer or designee acting pursuant to this subsection
- 24 shall be valid if the officer or designee reasonably believes a person
- 25 ordered to leave is under the influence of alcohol or drugs, is
- 26 committing acts, or is creating a disturbance as provided in this
- 27 subsection.

- 1 (2) It shall be unlawful for any person to refuse to leave public
- 2 property immediately adjacent to a building, grounds or property which
- 3 is owned, operated or controlled by a school district or approved
- 4 private school when ordered to do so by a law enforcement officer if
- 5 such person is engaging in conduct which creates a substantial risk of
- 6 causing injury to any person, or substantial harm to property, or such
- 7 conduct amounts to disorderly conduct under RCW 9A.84.030.
- 8 (3) It shall be unlawful for any person to interfere with school
- 9 <u>activities</u>. <u>Interfering with school activities means conduct committed</u>
- 10 while school is in session and the person is on public premises
- 11 adjacent to or on the grounds of any public or approved private school
- 12 <u>and the person:</u>
- 13 (a) Makes any noise or diversion that disturbs or tends to disturb
- 14 the peace or good order of a school session or a class and the person
- is requested to leave by a school authority; or
- 16 (b) Fails, following a request to do so, to leave the premises or
- 17 <u>immediate vicinity of the public or approved private school while the</u>
- 18 school is in session at the request of a school authority if the person
- 19 threatens to commit, or is initiating the commission by another of an
- 20 act that would disrupt, impair, interfere with, or obstruct the lawful
- 21 mission, process, procedures, or functions of the public or approved
- 22 private school.
- 23 (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit or
- 24 penalize activity consisting of the lawful exercise of freedom of
- 25 speech, freedom of press and the right to peaceably assemble and
- 26 petition the government for a redress of grievances: PROVIDED, That
- 27 such activity neither does or threatens imminently to materially
- 28 disturb or interfere with or obstruct any lawful task, function,
- 29 process or procedure of the school district, or any lawful task,
- 30 function, process or procedure of any student, official, employee or
