**Background:** The Child Care Facility Fund was established in 1989. The fund makes one-time loans or grants, or loan guarantees to individuals, businesses, and other organizations to start or expand a licensed child care facility. The loans, grants, or loan guarantees cannot exceed \$25,000.

The Child Care Facility Fund is administered by the Department of Trade and Economic Development's Business Assistance Center through a five member committee.

**Summary of Bill:** The Child Care Facility Fund becomes a revolving loan fund. The maximum loan amount per applicant is changed from \$25,000 to \$100,000.

**Fiscal Note:** Requested March 27, 1991.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.

**Testimony For:** This allows the loan repayments to be added to the fund and used without specific appropriations. Increasing the maximum loan amount gives the fund more flexibility.

**Testimony Against:** None.
