Synopsis As Enacted

Brief Description: Increasing the number of district judges.

Background: The minimum number of district court judges in each county is set by statute. Periodically, the number is adjusted to reflect shifts in population and caseloads.

Summary of Bill: The minimum numbers of district court judges in three counties are adjusted as follows:

- o King County from 24 to 26;
- o Pierce County from 8 to 11;
- o Spokane County from 8 to 9; and
- o Pacific County from 3 to 2.
