- 1 AN ACT Relating to continuing education credit requirements; and
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 28A.415 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.415
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 Credit earned by educational staff associates for taking courses
- 7 may be used to fulfill any applicable continuing education
- 8 certification credit requirements if: (1) The course may be used for
- 9 continuing education credit needed to maintain a professional license;
- 10 or (2) the course is sponsored by a state or national association, the
- 11 association is awarding professional continuing education credit to
- 12 course participants, and the educational staff associate is employed as
- 13 a psychologist, communication disorder specialist, nurse, occupational
- 14 therapist, physical therapist, counselor, or social worker.
