## SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1145

Read first time February 18, 1991.

- 1 AN ACT Relating to the American Indian endowed scholarship program;
- 2 and amending RCW 28B.108.010, 28B.108.030, 28B.108.050, 28B.108.060,
- 3 and 28B.108.070.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28B.108.010 and 1990 c 287 s 2 are each amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in
- 8 this section apply throughout this chapter.
- 9 (1) "Institution of higher education" or "institution" means a
- 10 college or university in the state of Washington which is accredited by
- 11 an accrediting association recognized as such by rule of the higher
- 12 education coordinating board.
- 13 (2) "Board" means the higher education coordinating board.
- 14 (3) "Eligible student" or "student" means an American Indian
- 15 ((student as defined by the board in consultation with the advisory

- 1 committee described in RCW 28B.108.030,)) who is a financially needy
- 2 student, as defined in RCW 28B.10.802, who is a resident student, as
- 3 defined by RCW 28B.15.012(2), who is a full-time student at an
- 4 institution of higher education, and who promises to use his or her
- 5 education to benefit other American Indians.
- 6 Sec. 2. RCW 28B.108.030 and 1990 c 287 s 4 are each amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 The higher education coordinating board shall establish an advisory
- 9 committee to assist in program design and to develop criteria for the
- 10 screening and selection of scholarship recipients. The committee shall
- 11 be composed of representatives of the same groups as the screening
- 12 committee described in RCW 28B.108.020. ((These)) The criteria shall
- 13 assess the student's social and cultural ties to an American Indian
- 14 community within the state. The criteria shall include a priority for
- 15 upper-division or graduate students. The criteria may include a
- 16 priority for students who are majoring in program areas in which
- 17 expertise is needed by the state's American Indians.
- 18 **Sec. 3.** RCW 28B.108.050 and 1990 c 287 s 6 are each amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- The American Indian endowed scholarship trust fund is established.
- 21 The trust fund shall be administered by the state treasurer. Funds
- 22 appropriated by the legislature for the trust fund shall be deposited
- 23 into the fund. All moneys deposited in the fund shall be invested by
- 24 the state treasurer. Notwithstanding RCW 43.84.090, all earnings of
- 25 investments of balances of the trust fund shall be credited to the
- 26 fund. At the request of the higher education coordinating board, and
- 27 when conditions set forth in RCW 28B.108.070 are met, the treasurer
- 28 shall ((<del>deposit</del>)) <u>transfer</u> state matching moneys ((<del>in</del>)) <u>and any earned</u>

- 1 <u>interest from</u> the trust fund ((into)) to the American Indian endowment
- 2 fund. No appropriation is required for expenditures from the trust
- 3 fund.
- 4 Sec. 4. RCW 28B.108.060 and 1990 c 287 s 7 are each amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 The American Indian scholarship endowment fund is established. The
- 7 endowment fund shall be administered by the state treasurer. Moneys
- 8 received from the higher education coordinating board, private
- 9 donations, state matching moneys and any earned interest, and funds
- 10 received from any other source may be deposited into the endowment
- 11 fund. All moneys deposited in the endowment fund shall be invested by
- 12 the state treasurer. Notwithstanding RCW 43.84.090, all earnings of
- 13 investments of balances of the endowment fund shall be credited to the
- 14 endowment fund. At the request of the higher education coordinating
- 15 board, the treasurer shall release earnings from the endowment fund to
- 16 the board for scholarships. No appropriation is required for
- 17 expenditures from the endowment fund.
- 18 The principal of the endowment fund shall not be invaded. The
- 19 earnings on the fund shall be used solely for the purposes set forth in
- 20 RCW 28B.108.040.
- 21 Sec. 5. RCW 28B.108.070 and 1990 c 287 s 8 are each amended to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 The higher education coordinating board may request that the
- 24 treasurer deposit ((five hundred)) fifty thousand dollars of state
- 25 matching funds and any earned interest into the American Indian
- 26 scholarship endowment fund when the board can match the state funds
- 27 with an equal amount of private cash donations. Private cash donations
- 28 means moneys from nonstate sources that include, but are not limited

- 1 to, federal moneys, tribal moneys, and assessments by commodity
- 2 commissions authorized to conduct research activities, including but
- 3 not limited to research studies authorized under RCW 15.66.030 and
- 4 15.65.040.
