**SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1328**

1            AN ACT Relating to special educational services demonstration  
2 projects; creating a new section; and making an appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.**            It is the intent of the legislature to  
5 establish special educational services demonstration projects.  
6 Substitute House Bill No. 1329 authorizes such projects, provides for  
7 in-service training and project evaluation, and creates a selection  
8 advisory committee.

9            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 2.**            The sum of one million seven hundred  
10 thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is  
11 appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, from the general  
12 fund to the superintendent of public instruction for the purposes of  
13 Substitute House Bill No. 1329.
