1 AN ACT Relating to maintaining the Washington state patrol crime  
2 laboratory system; creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The Washington state patrol shall  
5 maintain crime laboratories in at least the same locations as it did as  
6 of December 31, 1990, and shall provide services at each of those  
7 locations during the biennium beginning July 1, 1991.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate  
9 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
10 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
11 effect immediately.
