1 AN ACT Relating to the banning of liquor on college and university  
2 campuses and related facilities; adding a new section 66.44 RCW;  
3 prescribing penalties; and declaring an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 66.44 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7 It is a misdemeanor for a person, regardless of age, to possess,  
8 distribute, or consume liquor within a building, facility, residence,  
9 or on property located on a college or university campus. It is also  
10 a misdemeanor for a person to possess, distribute, or consume liquor  
11 within, or on the property of, a related living facility. For purposes  
12 of this section, "related living facility" means a building inhabited  
13 by members of an organization that assumes the college or university's  
14 name as a portion of its own or receives funding from the college or

1 university, and includes, but is not limited to, fraternity and  
2 sorority houses.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate  
4 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the  
5 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take  
6 effect immediately.
