1 AN ACT Relating to charges for space in the candidates' pamphlet;
2 and amending RCW 29.80.050.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29.80.050 and 1971 ex.s. c 145 s 3 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 Nominees shall pay for their prorated space in the candidates'
7 pamphlet allocated according to the respective offices sought as
8 follows:

9 (1) For United States senator, United States representative and
10 governor, each shall pay two hundred dollars. The nominees for each
11 position shall equally share no less than two full pages.

12 (2) For all state offices voted upon throughout the state, except
13 for that of governor, each shall pay one hundred dollars. The nominees
14 for each position shall equally share no less than one full page.

1 (3) For state senator, judge of the court of appeals and judge of
2 the superior court, each shall pay fifty dollars. The nominees for
3 each position shall equally share no less than one full page.

4 (4) For state representative, each shall pay twenty-five dollars.
5 The nominees for each position shall equally share no less than one-
6 half page.

7 (~~All such payments shall be made to the secretary of state when~~
8 ~~the statement is offered to him for filing and be transmitted by him to~~
9 ~~the public printer to be used as a credit offset to the cost of~~
10 ~~printing the candidates' and voters' pamphlet.)) The secretary of
11 state shall bill each candidate nominated for the candidate's prorated
12 space in the candidates' pamphlet. All such payments shall be made
13 directly to the secretary of state upon receipt of billing.~~

14 Nominees for president and vice-president of each political party
15 certified by the secretary of state shall together be entitled to one
16 page without charge. Each such page so allocated shall not contain
17 more than five hundred words in addition to the pictures of the
18 nominees concerned.
