- 1 AN ACT Relating to commercial fishing; adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 75.08 RCW; and creating new sections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that fish species
- 5 caught incidental to commercial net target fisheries in state waters
- 6 may negatively impact the nontarget species, and that the sale of
- 7 incidentally caught fish provides an economic benefit to commercial
- 8 fishers. The legislature further finds that limiting the commercial
- 9 harvest of and preventing the sale of certain fish species may improve
- 10 the status of the fishery in state waters.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 75.08 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 The director shall adopt rules that list each fish species that may
- 14 lawfully be commercially harvested and sold. A species list shall be

- 1 prepared for each management and catch reporting area designated by the
- 2 director, with associated seasons, open days, and open hours.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The department shall develop a study
- 4 plan and design for observing and documenting incidental catch of fish
- 5 in commercial fisheries, and shall present the study plan to the
- 6 legislature by October 1, 1991. The study plan shall include:
- 7 (1) Elements of an observer training program; and
- 8 (2) A sample design that will allow identification of causes for
- 9 incidental catch, and that will allow for future recommendations on how
- 10 to minimize incidental catch. Variables measured shall include, at a
- 11 minimum, mesh size, depth of net, distance from net to shore, gear
- 12 type, incidentally caught species, target species, and time of day.
