1 AN ACT Relating to teachers recruiting future teachers; adding a
2 new section to chapter 28A.300 RCW; creating a new section; and making
3 an appropriation.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The purpose of the teachers recruiting
6 future teachers program is to enlarge the pool of qualified high school
7 students who are motivated to become teachers.

8 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.300
9 RCW to read as follows:

10 (1) The teachers recruiting future teachers program is created.
11 Participating teachers shall make presentations to high school classes
12 discussing the rewards and challenges of teaching. Interested students
13 may meet monthly for four months with a participating teacher for
14 follow-up discussions on the issues in teaching.

1 (2) The superintendent of public instruction shall adopt rules to
2 implement this section.

3 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** The sum of one hundred eighty-nine
4 thousand nine hundred ninety dollars, or as much thereof as may be
5 necessary, is appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, from
6 the general fund to the superintendent of public instruction for the
7 purposes of this act.
