
HOUSE BILL 1999

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

By Representatives Holland and Grant.

Read first time February 18, 1991. Referred to Committee on Education.

1 AN ACT Relating to common school energy efficiency incentives; and
2 amending RCW 28A.505.100 and 28A.505.160.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 28A.505.100 and 1990 c 33 s 420 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) The budget shall set forth the estimated revenues for the
7 ensuing fiscal year, the estimated revenues for the fiscal year current
8 at the time of budget preparation, the actual revenues for the last
9 completed fiscal year, and the reserved and unreserved fund balances
10 for each year. The estimated revenues from all sources for the ensuing
11 fiscal year shall not include any revenue not anticipated to be
12 available during that fiscal year: PROVIDED, That school districts,
13 pursuant to RCW 28A.505.110 can be granted permission by the
14 superintendent of public instruction to include as revenues in their
15 budgets, receivables collectible in future fiscal years.

1 (2) The budget shall set forth by detailed items or classes the
2 estimated expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year, the estimated
3 expenditures for the fiscal year current at the time of budget
4 preparation, and the actual expenditures for the last completed fiscal
5 year. Total salary amounts, full-time equivalents, and the high, low,
6 and average annual salaries, shall be displayed by job classification
7 within each budget classification. If individual salaries within each
8 job classification are not displayed, districts shall provide the
9 individual salaries together with the title or position of the
10 recipient and the total amounts of salary under each budget class upon
11 request. Salary schedules shall be displayed. In districts where
12 negotiations have not been completed, the district may budget the
13 salaries at the current year's rate and restrict fund balance for the
14 amount of anticipated increase in salaries, so long as an explanation
15 shall be attached to the budget on such restriction of fund balance.

16 (3) The budget shall apportion the district energy budget to all
17 individual school buildings within the district. Savings from
18 underexpenditure of apportioned energy budgets shall be managed as
19 follows:

20 (a) Thirty percent of the savings shall be returned to the district
21 to be used as desired by the district.

22 (b) Seventy percent of the savings shall be retained by the
23 individual school to be used as desired by the individual school.

24 **Sec. 2.** RCW 28A.505.160 and 1975-'76 2nd ex.s. c 118 s 16 are each
25 amended to read as follows:

26 Except as provided in RCW 28A.505.100 and this section, all
27 appropriations for any school district upon which their budget is based
28 shall lapse at the end of the fiscal year. At the expiration of said
29 period all appropriations shall become null and void and any claim

1 presented thereafter against any such appropriation for the fiscal year
2 just closed shall be provided for in the appropriation for the next
3 fiscal year: PROVIDED, That this shall not prevent payments upon in
4 completed improvements in progress at the close of the fiscal year.
