- 1 AN ACT Relating to vehicle license, registration, and title fees;
- 2 amending RCW 46.01.140; and adding a new section to chapter 46.04 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 46.01.140 and 1990 c 250 s 89 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The county auditor, if appointed by the director of licensing
- 7 shall carry out the provisions of this title relating to the licensing
- 8 of vehicles and the issuance of vehicle license number plates under the
- 9 direction and supervision of the director and may with the approval of
- 10 the director appoint assistants as special deputies and subagents to
- 11 accept applications and collect fees for vehicle licenses and transfers
- 12 and to deliver vehicle license number plates.
- 13 (2) At any time any application is made to the director, the county
- 14 auditor, or other agent pursuant to any law dealing with licenses,
- 15 registration, or the right to operate any vehicle upon the public

- 1 highways of this state, excluding applicants already paying such fee
- 2 under RCW 46.16.070 or 46.16.085, the applicant shall pay to the
- 3 director, county auditor, or other agent a fee of two dollars for each
- 4 application in addition to any other fees required by law. Applicants
- 5 for certificates of ownership, including applicants paying fees under
- 6 RCW 46.16.070 or 46.16.085, shall pay to the director, county auditor,
- 7 or other agent a fee of three dollars in addition to any other fees
- 8 required by law. These ((additional)) fees, if paid to the county
- 9 auditor as agent of the director, or if paid to ((an agent)) a subagent
- 10 of the county auditor, shall be paid to the county treasurer in the
- 11 same manner as other fees collected by the county auditor and credited
- 12 to the county current expense fund. ((If the fee is paid to another
- 13 agent of the director, the fee shall be used by the agent to defray his
- 14 or her expenses in handling the application: PROVIDED, That an agent
- 15 of the county auditor is entitled to an additional service charge of
- 16 two dollars)).
- 17 (3) <u>Subagents shall collect a service fee of (a) five dollars and</u>
- 18 fifty cents for changes in a certificate of ownership, with or without
- 19 registration renewal, or verification of record and preparation of an
- 20 <u>affidavit of lost title other than at the time of title application or</u>
- 21 transfer and (b) two dollars and twenty-five cents for registration
- 22 renewal only, issuing a transit permit, or any other service under this
- 23 section.
- 24 (4) If the fee is collected by the state patrol as agent for the
- 25 director, the fee so collected shall be certified to the state
- 26 treasurer and deposited to the credit of the state patrol highway
- 27 account. If the fee is collected by the department of transportation
- 28 as agent for the director, the fee shall be certified to the state
- 29 treasurer and deposited to the credit of the motor vehicle fund. All
- 30 such fees collected by the director or branches of his or her office

- 1 shall be certified to the state treasurer and deposited to the credit
- 2 of the highway safety fund.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.04 RCW
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 "County auditor" includes, in charter counties, the office
- 6 designated to issue motor vehicle licenses.
