## HOUSE BILL 2449

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1992 Regular Session

- 1 AN ACT Relating to funding for traffic safety education programs;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 82.08 RCW; creating a new section;
- 3 making an appropriation; providing an effective date; and declaring an
- 4 emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that traffic
- 7 safety education programs offer students the necessary skills and
- 8 knowledge to become safe, responsible operators of motor vehicles, and
- 9 reduce the incidence of motor vehicle accidents among teenage drivers.
- 10 Therefore, the intent of section 2 of this act is to provide a
- 11 dedicated revenue source for traffic safety education programs.
- 12 It is also the intent of the legislature that students from
- 13 families with limited financial resources be given higher priority in
- 14 allocating the funding provided by section 2 of this act.

- 1 It is further the intent of the legislature that the adequacy and
- 2 appropriateness of the amount and source of funding under section 2 of
- 3 this act be periodically reviewed.
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 82.08 RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) In addition to other taxes imposed in this chapter, a tax of
- 7 two dollars per day or part of a day is imposed on each retail sale
- 8 that is a lease or rental of a motor vehicle licensed for hire,
- 9 regardless of whether the vehicle is licensed in this state. This tax
- 10 applies only to rentals and leases of motor vehicles designed to carry
- 11 less than nine passengers, and only to the first thirty days of the
- 12 rental or lease term.
- 13 (2) The tax imposed in this section is part of the selling price
- 14 for purposes of the tax imposed in RCW 82.08.020.
- 15 (3) Revenue from the tax imposed in this section shall be deposited
- 16 in the general fund and used solely for funding traffic safety
- 17 education programs.
- 18 (4) Before January 1, 1995, and January 1, of each fifth year
- 19 thereafter:
- 20 (a) The department of revenue shall provide the legislature with an
- 21 updated estimate of the amount of revenue attributable to the tax
- 22 imposed in this section, with detail by type of rental or lease
- 23 transaction.
- 24 (b) The superintendent of public instruction shall provide the
- 25 legislature with a report on the adequacy and appropriateness of the
- 26 level of funding provided under this section.
- 27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The sum of eight million dollars, or as
- 28 much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the general fund

- 1 to the superintendent of public instruction for the biennium ending
- 2 June 30, 1993, solely for the purposes of traffic safety education
- 3 programs.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 5 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 6 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 7 effect April 1, 1992.
