- 1 AN ACT Relating to building permit verification; amending RCW
- 2 36.21.080 and 19.27.140; and adding a new section to chapter 19.27 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 36.21.080 and 1989 c 246 s 4 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The county assessor is authorized to place any property that is
- 7 increased in value due to construction or alteration for which a
- 8 building permit was issued, or should have been issued, under chapter
- 9 19.27, 19.27A, or 19.28 RCW or other laws providing for building
- 10 permits on the assessment rolls for the purposes of tax levy up to
- 11 August 31st of each year. The assessed valuation of the property shall
- 12 be considered as of July 31st of that year.
- 13 (2) In conducting a physical appraisal under RCW 36.21.070 or
- 14 subsection (1) of this section, the county assessor shall verify that

- 1 all necessary building permits required under chapter 19.27, 19.27A, or
- 2 19.28 RCW or other laws providing for building permits have been
- 3 issued. The county assessor shall immediately notify the local
- 4 <u>building official if all necessary building permits have not been</u>
- 5 <u>issued</u>.
- 6 Sec. 2. RCW 19.27.140 and 1989 c 246 s 5 are each amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 A copy of any permit obtained under the state building code for
- 9 construction or alteration work of a total cost or fair market value in
- 10 excess of five hundred dollars, shall be transmitted by the issuing
- 11 authority to the county assessor and the county auditor of the county
- 12 where the property on which the construction or alteration work is
- 13 located. The building permit shall contain the county assessor's
- 14 parcel number.
- 15 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 19.27 RCW
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 A copy of any certificate of occupancy issued upon completion of
- 18 construction or alteration work on a single or multifamily residential
- 19 building shall be transmitted by the issuing authority to the county
- 20 auditor of the county where the property on which the construction or
- 21 alteration work is located. The certificate of occupancy shall contain
- 22 the county assessor's parcel number.
