- 1 AN ACT Relating to motor vehicle licensing fees; and amending RCW
- 2 82.80.020.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 82.80.020 and 1991 c 318 s 13 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) The legislative authority of a county may fix and impose an
- 7 additional fee, not to exceed fifteen dollars per vehicle, for each
- 8 vehicle that is subject to license fees under RCW 46.16.060 and is
- 9 determined by the department of licensing to be registered within the
- 10 boundaries of the county.
- 11 (2) The department of licensing shall administer and collect the
- 12 fee. The department shall deduct a percentage amount, as provided by
- 13 contract, not to exceed two percent of the taxes collected, for
- 14 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining

- 1 proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer for
- 2 monthly distribution under RCW 82.80.080.
- 3 (3) The proceeds of this fee shall be used strictly for
- 4 transportation purposes in accordance with RCW 82.80.070.
- 5 (4) A county imposing this fee shall delay the effective date at
- 6 least six months from the date the ordinance is enacted to allow the
- 7 department of licensing to implement administration and collection of
- 8 the fee.
- 9 (5)(a) The legislative authority of a county may ((develop and
- 10 initiate a refund process of)) exempt payment of the ((fifteen dollar
- 11 fee to)) fee from the registered owners of vehicles residing within the
- 12 boundaries of the county who are sixty-one years old or older at the
- 13 time of payment of the fee and whose household income for the previous
- 14 calendar year is eighteen thousand dollars or less or who has a
- 15 physical disability ((and who has paid the fifteen dollar additional
- 16 fee)).
- 17 (b) The director of licensing shall adopt rules establishing the
- 18 method of proof required for qualifying for the exemptions under (a) of
- 19 this subsection.
