- 1 AN ACT Relating to state employee safety at eastern and western
- 2 state hospitals; creating a new section; and making an appropriation.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The department of labor and industries
- 5 shall conduct a study to investigate the problems and causes associated
- 6 with assaults on state employees who work at eastern and western state
- 7 hospitals. The study will include, but not be limited to, the possible
- 8 ameliorative actions of increased staffing levels, increased employee
- 9 training, and physical plant improvements. In their study the
- 10 department shall consult with state employees and their
- 11 representatives; department of social and health services and hospital
- 12 management; advocates of the mentally ill; patients or former patients
- 13 of state mental hospitals; persons with demonstrated expertise in
- 14 managing assaultive and self destructive behavior; and others with an

- 1 interest in this issue. The department shall report back to the
- 2 legislature regarding its findings and recommendations by December 31,
- 3 1993.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of ninety thousand dollars from
- 5 the accident fund and the sum of ninety thousand dollars from the
- 6 medical fund, or as much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated
- 7 for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, to the department of labor and
- 8 industries for the purpose of this act.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** If any provision of this act or its
- 10 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 11 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 12 persons or circumstances is not affected.
