1 AN ACT Relating to employment protection for classified school
2 employees; adding a new section to chapter 28A.320 RCW; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.320
6 RCW to read as follows:

7 (1) A school district or board of directors may purchase services
8 by contract with individuals or business entities if those services
9 were regularly purchased by valid contract at the districts prior to
10 the effective date of this act. However, no such contract may be
11 executed or renewed if it would have the effect of terminating
12 classified employees or classified employee positions existing at the
13 time of the execution or renewal of the contract, except for employees
14 in director/supervisor and professional positions.

1 (2) For the purposes of this section:

2 (a) "Director/supervisor position" means a position in which an
3 employee directs staff members and manages a function, a program, or a
4 support service.

5 (b) "Professional position" means a position for which an employee
6 is required to have a high degree of knowledge and skills acquired
7 through a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent.

8 (3) This section shall not apply to the purchase of services by
9 contract with educational service districts under RCW 28A.310.180,
10 pursuant to cooperative projects under RCW 28A.340.020 through
11 28A.340.070, or with other school districts, if the school district
12 classified employees whose employment is affected by the contract are
13 transferred to comparable positions with the educational service
14 district or another school district.

15 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** If any provision of this act or its
16 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
17 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
18 persons or circumstances is not affected.

19 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
20 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
21 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
22 effect immediately.
