- 1 AN ACT Relating to school districts; and adding a new section to
- 2 chapter 28A.315 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28A.315
- 5 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) No school district in the state may enroll more than thirty
- 7 thousand full-time equivalent students.
- 8 (2) All school districts with enrollments of thirty thousand or
- 9 more full-time equivalent students on the effective date of this
- 10 section shall initiate a process to divide the district into two or
- 11 more separate school districts. The process shall include the
- 12 formation of an advisory committee composed of district personnel,
- 13 parents, and community members to be appointed by the school district's
- 14 board of directors. Members on the advisory committee shall reflect

- 1 the cultural diversity of the school district's student population.
- 2 The advisory committee shall make recommendations to the school
- 3 district's board of directors on the following matters: (a) Boundaries
- 4 of the new school districts; (b) governance, organizational, and
- 5 administrative matters pertaining to the formation of a new school
- 6 district or districts; (c) equitable division of capital and financial
- 7 assets between the new districts; (d) adjustments in bonded
- 8 indebtedness; and (e) a plan for making an orderly transition from one
- 9 to two or more school districts. Recommendations of the advisory
- 10 committee shall be submitted to the district's board of directors by
- 11 July 1, 1993, and shall be acted upon by the district's board of
- 12 directors in time to effectuate the division of the school district,
- 13 and the creation of one or more new school districts, before September
- 14 1, 1994.
- 15 (3) Any district that projects that its full-time equivalent
- 16 student enrollment will exceed thirty thousand shall initiate the
- 17 process provided in subsection (2) of this section in such a manner
- 18 that the division of the district occurs before the district's
- 19 enrollment exceeds thirty thousand full-time equivalent students.
- 20 (4) The provisions of RCW 28A.315.010 through 28A.315.270
- 21 pertaining to the initiation and formation of new school districts and
- 22 division of assets shall not be applicable.
