- 1 AN ACT Relating to taxes imposed on the sale or use of medical
- 2 supplies and equipment; amending RCW 82.08.0283 and 82.12.0277; and
- 3 providing an effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.08.0283 and 1991 c 250 s 2 are each amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (1) The tax levied by RCW 82.08.020 shall not apply to sales of
- 8 insulin; prosthetic and orthotic devices prescribed for an individual
- 9 by a person licensed under chapters 18.25, 18.57, or 18.71 RCW or
- 10 dispensed or fitted by a person licensed under chapter 18.35 RCW;
- 11 ostomic items; ((and)) medically prescribed oxygen; and sales of
- 12 durable medical equipment to individuals sixty-five years of age and
- 13 older.

- 1 (2) For the purposes of this section, "medically prescribed oxygen"
- 2 includes, but is not limited to, sale or rental of oxygen concentrator
- 3 systems, oxygen enricher systems, liquid oxygen systems, and gaseous,
- 4 bottled oxygen systems to an individual under a prescription issued by
- 5 a person licensed under chapter 18.57 or 18.71 RCW for use in the
- 6 medical treatment of that individual.
- 7 (3) For purposes of this section, "durable medical equipment" means
- 8 <u>equipment that:</u>
- 9 <u>(a) Is primarily and customarily used to serve a medical purpose;</u>
- 10 (b) Generally is not useful to a person in the absence of illness
- 11 <u>or injury;</u>
- 12 (c) Is designed for use in a residence; and
- (d) Includes such items of equipment as hospital beds, wheelchairs,
- 14 crutches, walkers, canes, blood pressure kits, or blood glucose
- 15 monitoring kits.
- 16 Sec. 2. RCW 82.12.0277 and 1991 c 250 s 3 are each amended to read
- 17 as follows:
- 18 (1) The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to
- 19 the use of insulin; prosthetic and orthotic devices prescribed for an
- 20 individual by a person licensed under chapters 18.25, 18.57, or 18.71
- 21 RCW or dispensed or fitted by a person licensed under chapter 18.35
- 22 RCW; ostomic items; ((and)) medically prescribed oxygen; and the use of
- 23 durable medical equipment by individuals sixty-five years of age and
- 24 <u>older</u>.
- 25 (2) For the purposes of this section, "medically prescribed oxygen"
- 26 includes, but is not limited to, ((<del>sale or rental</del>)) <u>use</u> of oxygen
- 27 concentrator systems, oxygen enricher systems, liquid oxygen systems,
- 28 and gaseous, bottled oxygen systems ((to)) by an individual under a

- 3 (3) For purposes of this section, "durable medical equipment" means

- 7 <u>or injury;</u>
- 8 (c) Is designed for use in a residence; and
- 9 (d) Includes such items of equipment as hospital beds, wheelchairs,
- 10 crutches, walkers, canes, blood pressure kits, or blood glucose
- 11 monitoring kits.
