1 AN ACT Relating to campaign financing and public disclosure for the
2 office of state treasurer; amending RCW 42.17.2401; and adding a new
3 section to chapter 42.17 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 42.17 RCW
6 to read as follows:

7 (1) A general partner of the state investment board or an active
8 money manager doing business with the state investment board may not
9 contribute, directly or indirectly, to any candidate for the office of
10 state treasurer.

11 (2) A candidate for the office of state treasurer may not knowingly
12 accept any contribution from a general partner of the state investment
13 board or an active money manager doing business with the state
14 investment board.

1 (3) The prohibitions in subsection (1) and (2) of this section do
2 not apply to contributions received from businesses doing business with
3 the state that was granted through a formal bid process.

4 **Sec. 2.** RCW 42.17.2401 and 1991 c 200 s 404 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 For the purposes of RCW 42.17.240, the term "executive state
7 officer" includes:

8 (1) The chief administrative law judge, the director of
9 agriculture, the administrator of the office of marine safety, the
10 administrator of the Washington basic health plan, the director of the
11 department of services for the blind, the director of the state system
12 of community colleges, the director of community development, the
13 secretary of corrections, the director of ecology, the commissioner of
14 employment security, the chairman of the energy facility site
15 evaluation council, the director of the energy office, the secretary of
16 the state finance committee, the director of financial management, the
17 director of fisheries, the executive secretary of the forest practices
18 appeals board, the director of the gambling commission, the director of
19 general administration, the secretary of health, the administrator of
20 the Washington state health care authority, the executive secretary of
21 the health care facilities authority, the executive secretary of the
22 higher education facilities authority, the director of the higher
23 education personnel board, the executive secretary of the horse racing
24 commission, the executive secretary of the human rights commission, the
25 executive secretary of the indeterminate sentence review board, the
26 director of the department of information services, the director of the
27 interagency committee for outdoor recreation, the executive director of
28 the state investment board, the director of labor and industries, the
29 director of licensing, the director of the lottery commission, the

1 director of the office of minority and women's business enterprises,
2 the director of parks and recreation, the director of personnel, the
3 executive director of the public disclosure commission, the director of
4 retirement systems, the director of revenue, the secretary of social
5 and health services, the chief of the Washington state patrol, the
6 executive secretary of the board of tax appeals, the director of trade
7 and economic development, the secretary of transportation, the
8 secretary of the utilities and transportation commission, the director
9 of veterans affairs, the director of wildlife, the president of each of
10 the regional and state universities and the president of The Evergreen
11 State College, each district and each campus president of each state
12 community college;

13 (2) Each professional staff member of the office of the governor;

14 (3) Each professional staff member of the legislature; ((and))

15 (4) Central Washington University board of trustees, board of
16 trustees of each community college, each member of the state board for
17 community college education, state convention and trade center board of
18 directors, board of pilotage, committee for deferred compensation,
19 Eastern Washington University board of trustees, Washington economic
20 development finance authority, The Evergreen State College board of
21 trustees, forest practices appeals board, forest practices board,
22 gambling commission, Washington health care facilities authority,
23 higher education coordinating board, higher education facilities
24 authority, higher education personnel board, horse racing commission,
25 state housing finance commission, human rights commission,
26 indeterminate sentence review board, board of industrial insurance
27 appeals, information services board, interagency committee for outdoor
28 recreation, state investment board, liquor control board, lottery
29 commission, marine oversight board, oil and gas conservation committee,
30 Pacific Northwest electric power and conservation planning council,

1 parks and recreation commission, personnel appeals board, personnel
2 board, pollution control hearings board, public disclosure commission,
3 public pension commission, shorelines hearing board, state employees'
4 benefits board, board of tax appeals, transportation commission,
5 University of Washington board of regents, utilities and transportation
6 commission, Washington state maritime commission, Washington public
7 power supply system executive board, Washington State University board
8 of regents, Western Washington University board of trustees, and
9 wildlife commission; and

10 (5) Within the office of the state treasurer the following
11 professional staff members: Assistant treasurer, deputy treasurer,
12 legal counsel, and investment officer.
