- AN ACT Relating to special districts; amending RCW 85.22.010;
- 2 adding a new sections to chapter 85.38 RCW; and repealing RCW
- 3 85.07.080.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 85.22.010 and 1933 c 182 s 1 are each amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 Any diking district ((organized under the provisions of chapter
- 8 CXVII (117) of the Laws of 1895, and the acts amendatory thereof, which
- 9 has been reorganized under the provisions of chapter 131 of the Laws of
- 10 1917, and the acts amendatory thereof, and any)); drainage district
- 11 ((organized under the provisions of chapter CXV (115) of the Laws of
- 12 1895, and the acts amendatory thereof, whether the same has been
- 13 organized as a drainage and irrigation improvement district or as a
- 14 drainage district,)); irrigation district; intercounty diking and

- 1 drainage district; diking, drainage, and/or sewerage improvement
- 2 <u>district;</u> consolidated diking district, drainage district, diking
- 3 improvement district, and/or drainage improvement district; or flood
- 4 <u>control district</u> may reorganize as a drainage and irrigation
- 5 improvement district or as a diking, drainage and irrigation
- 6 improvement district in the manner provided in this chapter.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 85.38 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 A special district may withdraw area from its boundaries that is
- 10 located within the boundaries of a city or town, or area that includes
- 11 area both within and adjacent to the boundaries of any city or town,
- 12 under this section.
- 13 (1) The withdrawal of area is authorized upon the following
- 14 conditions being met: (a) Adoption of a resolution by the special
- 15 district requesting withdrawal of the area from the district; (b)
- 16 adoption of a resolution by the city or town council approving the
- 17 withdrawal of the special district from the area; (c) assumption by the
- 18 city or town of full responsibility for the maintenance, improvements,
- 19 and collection of payment for the operation of the system previously
- 20 operated by the special district in the area; (d) transfer by the
- 21 special district of all rights-of-way or easements in the area to the
- 22 city or town by quit claim or deed; and (e) adoption of an interlocal
- 23 agreement between the special district and the city or town that
- 24 reimburses the special district for lost assessment revenue from the
- 25 withdrawn area, that transfers any facilities or improvements owned by
- 26 the special district to the city or town as agreed between the parties,
- 27 and that requires the city or town to maintain existing water run-off
- 28 and water quality levels in the area.

- 1 (2) Property in the territory withdrawn from the boundaries of a
- 2 special district under this section shall remain liable for any special
- 3 assessments of the special district from which it was withdrawn, if the
- 4 special assessments are associated with bonds or notes used to finance
- 5 facilities serving the property, to the same extent as if the
- 6 withdrawal of property had not occurred.
- 7 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. RCW 85.07.080 and 1983 c 167 s 191 and
- 8 1935 c 103 s 3 are each repealed.
