- 1 AN ACT Relating to reducing capital expenditures in the 1991-93
- 2 capital budget; amending 1991 sp.s. c 14 s 1 (uncodified); creating new
- 3 sections; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The intent of this act is to provide
- 6 additional funds for the purpose of common school construction and to
- 7 review all capital appropriations that have not been spent or committed
- 8 by contract. No less than one-half of the funds lapsed from the state
- 9 building construction account as a result of this act are intended to
- 10 be appropriated to the state board of education for common school
- 11 construction for the period ending June 30, 1993. After the state
- 12 economy improves, capital projects that had funds reduced as a result
- 13 of this act may be reappropriated.

- 1 Sec. 2. 1991 sp.s. c 14 s 1 (uncodified) is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 A capital budget is hereby adopted and, subject to the provisions
- 4 set forth in ((this act)) chapter 14, Laws of 1991 sp. sess., the
- 5 several dollar amounts hereinafter specified, or so much thereof as
- 6 shall be sufficient to accomplish the purposes designated, are hereby
- 7 appropriated and authorized to be incurred for capital projects during
- 8 the period ending ((June 30, 1993)) the effective date of this act;
- 9 except for appropriations under sections 16, 29, 30, and 31, chapter
- 10 14, Laws of 1991 sp. sess. (uncodified) and any sections of chapter 14,
- 11 Laws of 1991 sp. sess., with matching federal funds, which are
- 12 appropriated and authorized to be incurred for capital projects during
- 13 the period ending June 30, 1993, out of the several funds specified in
- 14 ((this act)) chapter 14, Laws of 1991 sp. sess. All appropriations in
- 15 chapter 14, Laws of 1991 sp. sess. other than those exempted by this
- 16 act that are not spent or contractually obligated, including contracts
- 17 for construction, predesign, and design shall lapse.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The office of financial management shall
- 19 report the total amount of appropriations that lapse as a result of
- 20 this act to the house of representatives and senate fiscal committees
- 21 within fifteen days after the effective date of this act. The report
- 22 shall break out the total by agency and fund account.
- 23 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 24 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 25 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 26 effect immediately.
