- 1 AN ACT Relating to terrorism; adding new sections to chapter 9.41
- 2 RCW; creating a new section; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds:
- 5 (1) Some individuals have determined that discharging firearms
- 6 under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life
- 7 is an appropriate form of conduct.
- 8 (2) The discharge of firearms under circumstances manifesting an
- 9 extreme indifference to human life has as an intended consequence the
- 10 terrorizing of the community where discharge occurs.
- 11 (3) Current statutes against the discharge of firearms under
- 12 circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life are
- 13 inadequate to address the nature and seriousness of the assaults
- 14 against our communities now being conducted.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Sections 2 through 5 of this act are
- 2 intended to supplement existing laws against the discharge of firearms
- 3 under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to human life
- 4 and may be cited as the anti-terrorist act of 1992.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** It is unlawful for a person to discharge
- 6 a firearm under circumstances manifesting an extreme indifference to
- 7 human life. Violation of sections 2 through 5 of this act is a class
- 8 A felony.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A firearm used in violation of sections
- 10 2 through 5 of this act, and an automobile used during the commission
- 11 of the offense, shall be forfeited to the jurisdiction making the
- 12 arrest.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** In the event that a person is killed as
- 14 result of a discharge of a firearm under circumstances manifesting an
- 15 extreme indifference to human life, the person responsible for the
- 16 discharge shall be tried for aggravated first degree murder and subject
- 17 to capital punishment as provided in chapter 10.95 RCW.
- 18 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** If any provision of this act or its
- 19 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 20 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 21 persons or circumstances is not affected.
- 22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Sections 2 through 5 of this act are
- 23 each added to chapter 9.41 RCW.
