
HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 4416

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

By Representatives Anderson, McLean, Jones, Rasmussen, Winsley, Kremen and Bowman.

Read first time April 18, 1991. Referred to Committee on Rules Review.

1 WHEREAS, Issues raised during this legislative session have
2 underscored that there is a need to provide properly for those who are
3 currently giving service or have given service to their state and
4 country; and

5 WHEREAS, The veterans, members of the active duty military forces,
6 and members of the national guard and reserve components in Washington
7 state, must have consideration given to their unique concerns and the
8 programs designed for their assistance;

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the House of Representatives of
10 the state of Washington, the Senate concurring, That a Joint Select
11 Committee on Veterans and Military Personnel Affairs is created; and

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee consist of twelve
13 members, three from each caucus of the Senate, appointed by the
14 President of the Senate, and three from each caucus of the House of
15 Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of
16 Representatives; and

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall report to the
2 legislature before the 1992 legislative session on the current status
3 of veteran, and military personnel affairs in the state of Washington;
4 and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the committee shall establish an
6 advisory group of all interested parties and have access to and the
7 assistance of legislative staff and employees of state agencies as
8 necessary to perform the study and develop recommendations.
