- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, Some recent scientific studies suggest a possible link
- 9 between exposure to electric and magnetic fields and human health
- 10 effects; and
- 11 WHEREAS, There has been increasing public attention and concern
- 12 about possible health effects from electric and magnetic fields (EMF);
- 13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, Electricity is essential to the productivity, health, and
- 15 security of all people in the United States; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is recognized that there is a clear need for a solid
- 17 scientific basis for decision making on the EMF issue, particularly

- 1 with respect to the confident establishment of standards for field
- 2 strength exposures; and
- 3 WHEREAS, it is also recognized that individual states and local
- 4 jurisdictions do not have the resources to conduct thorough and
- 5 conclusive scientific research on the health effects of EMF; and
- 6 WHEREAS, It is in the nation's best interest to address the
- 7 possible health effects of EMF on a national basis, through research
- 8 conducted by an independent institution with a credible track record in
- 9 public health research;
- 10 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 11 Congress of the United States provide, alone or in conjunction with
- 12 other public and private entities, additional funding to expand and
- 13 accelerate a national research program to address and resolve the
- 14 growing concern about possible health effects from electric and
- 15 magnetic fields.
- 16 BE IT RESOLVED, That the research program be overseen by an
- 17 independent advisory board consisting of top-level officials from
- 18 federal agencies, state health departments, and public utility
- 19 commissions; and
- 20 BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 21 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 22 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 23 House of Representatives, and to each member of Congress from the State
- 24 of Washington.
