- 1 TO THE HONORABLE GEORGE BUSH, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES, AND
- 2 TO THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE AND THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF
- 3 REPRESENTATIVES, AND TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE
- 4 UNITED STATES, IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED:
- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of
- 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully
- 7 represent and petition as follows:
- 8 WHEREAS, Public concern about protecting the global environment
- 9 continues to grow as evidence mounts of the long-term damage being done
- 10 to the Earth by global climate change, toxic waste, freshwater and
- ocean pollution, and loss of biological diversity; and 11
- 12 WHEREAS, Environmental problems are inextricably linked with
- 13 economic and trade policies; and
- 14 WHEREAS, States have many critical responsibilities with respect to
- 15 supporting responsible economic development as well as for
- 16 environmental protection and natural resource management including

- 1 land-use planning, transportation, solid and hazardous waste
- 2 management, and procurement policies; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Washington state legislature has enacted numerous
- 4 measures to protect the environment and promote economic development in
- 5 areas such as toxic waste management, recycling, nuclear waste cleanup,
- 6 growth management, agricultural lands preservation, pesticide
- 7 application, air quality, solid waste management, and oil spill
- 8 prevention; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The Washington state legislature has also supported
- 10 national initiatives which enable states to develop and implement
- 11 successful economic development and environmental protection programs;
- 12 and
- 13 WHEREAS, The Washington state legislature recognizes that problems
- 14 such as global climate change, diminishing biological diversity, and
- 15 ocean pollution can only be solved with cooperation at all levels of
- 16 government from the local to the international; and
- 17 WHEREAS, In June of 1992, the world's leaders will gather in Rio de
- 18 Janeiro, Brazil, for the United Nations Conference on Environment and
- 19 Development (UNCED, otherwise known as the Earth Summit) to define new
- 20 and bold steps to achieve solutions to the planet's environmental and
- 21 economic development problems; and
- 22 WHEREAS, The Earth Summit will pay special attention to concerns
- 23 regarding global climate change, toxic waste, diminishing biological
- 24 diversity, and ocean and freshwater resources;
- 25 BE IT RESOLVED, That the Washington state legislature endorses the
- 26 goals and objectives of the Earth Summit particularly with respect to
- 27 the creation and adoption of global agreements which will result in
- 28 policies and mechanisms to protect the global environment and enhance
- 29 the ability of nations to equitably develop their natural and human
- 30 resources.

- 1 NOW, THEREFORE, Your Memorialists respectfully pray that the
- 2 President of the United States join his counterparts from around the
- 3 world at the Earth Summit, and instruct United States negotiators to
- 4 work with other national delegations in crafting an international
- 5 protocol on global climate change that would reduce this nation's
- 6 emissions of CO by twenty percent by the year 2000, and thus
- 7 reestablish the United States' role as a leader in managing the
- 8 planet's resources for present and future generations.
- 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That copies of this Memorial be immediately
- 10 transmitted to the Honorable George Bush, President of the United
- 11 States, the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
- 12 House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of
- 13 Washington.
