- 1 AN ACT Relating to per diem compensation; and amending RCW
- 2 85.05.410, 85.06.380, 85.08.320, and 85.24.080.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 85.05.410 and 1985 c 396 s 39 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Members of the board of diking commissioners of any diking district
- 7 in this state may receive as compensation the sum of up to ((twenty-
- 8 five)) fifty dollars for attendance at official meetings of the
- 9 district and for each day or major part thereof for all necessary
- 10 services actually performed in connection with their duties as
- 11 commissioners, and shall receive the same compensation as other labor
- 12 of a like character for all other necessary work or services performed
- 13 in connection with their duties: PROVIDED, That such compensation
- 14 shall not exceed ((three)) four thousand eight hundred dollars in one

- 1 calendar year, except when the commissioners declare an emergency.
- 2 Allowance of such compensation shall be established and approved at
- 3 regular meetings of the board, and when a copy of the extracts of
- 4 minutes of the board meeting relative thereto showing such approval is
- 5 certified by the secretary of such board and filed with the county
- 6 auditor, the allowance made shall be paid as are other claims against
- 7 the district.
- 8 Each commissioner is entitled to reimbursement for reasonable
- 9 expenses actually incurred in connection with such business, including
- 10 subsistence and lodging, while away from the commissioner's place of
- 11 residence, and mileage for use of a privately owned vehicle in
- 12 accordance with chapter 42.24 RCW.
- 13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 85.06.380 and 1985 c 396 s 43 are each amended to read
- 14 as follows:
- In performing their duties under the provisions of this title the
- 16 board and members of the board of drainage commissioners shall receive
- 17 as compensation up to ((twenty-five)) fifty dollars for attendance at
- 18 official meetings of the district and for each day or major part
- 19 thereof for all necessary services actually performed in connection
- 20 with their duties as commissioners: PROVIDED, That such compensation
- 21 <u>shall not exceed four thousand eight hundred dollars in one calendar</u>
- 22 year: PROVIDED FURTHER, That such services and compensation are
- 23 allowed and approved at a regular meeting of the board. Upon the
- 24 submission of a copy, certified by the secretary, of the extracts of
- 25 the relevant minutes of the board showing such approval, to the county
- 26 auditor, the same shall be paid as other claims against the district
- 27 are paid. Each commissioner is entitled to reimbursement for
- 28 reasonable expenses actually incurred in connection with such business,
- 29 including his subsistence and lodging, while away from the

- 1 commissioner's place of residence and mileage for use of a privately-
- 2 owned vehicle in accordance with chapter 42.24 RCW.
- 3 **Sec. 3.** RCW 85.08.320 and 1986 c 278 s 32 are each amended to read 4 as follows:
- 5 The compensation of the superintendent of construction, the board of appraisers hereinafter provided for, and any special engineer, 6 attorney or agent employed by the district in connection with the 7 8 improvement, the maximum wages to be paid, and the maximum price of 9 materials to be used, shall be fixed by the district board of Members of the board of supervisors may receive 10 supervisors. compensation up to ((twenty-five)) fifty dollars for attending each 11 12 official meeting of the district and for each day or major part thereof 13 for all necessary services actually performed in connection with their duties as supervisors: PROVIDED, That such compensation shall not 14 exceed four thousand eight hundred dollars in one calendar year. Each 15 16 supervisor shall be entitled to reimbursement for reasonable expenses 17 actually incurred in connection with business, including subsistence 18 and lodging while away from the supervisor's place of residence and 19 mileage for use of a privately owned vehicle in accordance with chapter 20 42.24 RCW. All costs of construction or maintenance done under the direction of the board of supervisors shall be paid upon vouchers or 21 payrolls verified by two of the said supervisors. All costs of 22 23 construction and all other expenses, fees and charges on account of 24 such improvement shall be paid by warrants drawn by the county auditor 25 upon the county treasurer upon the proper fund, and shall draw interest at a rate determined by the county legislative authority until paid or 26

called by the county treasurer as warrants of the county are called.

- 1 **Sec. 4.** RCW 85.24.080 and 1985 c 396 s 54 are each amended to read 2 as follows:
- 3 The members of the board shall receive as compensation up to ((twenty-five)) fifty dollars for attendance at official meetings of 4 the district and for each day or major part thereof for all necessary 5 6 services actually performed in connection with their duties as commissioners: PROVIDED, That such compensation shall not exceed four 7 thousand eight hundred dollars in one calendar year: PROVIDED FURTHER, 8 9 That the board may fix a different salary for the secretary thereof in 10 lieu of the per diem. Each commissioner is entitled to reimbursement 11 for reasonable expenses actually incurred in connection with such 12 business, including subsistence and lodging, while away from the 13 commissioner's place of residence, and mileage for use of a privately 14 owned vehicle in accordance with chapter 42.24 RCW. The salary and 15 expenses shall be paid by the treasurer of the fund, upon orders made Each member of the board must before being paid for 16 by the board. 17 expenses, take vouchers therefore from the person or persons to whom 18 the particular amount was paid, and must also make affidavit that the 19 amounts were necessarily incurred and expended in the performance of 20 his duties.
