1 AN ACT Relating to compensation for jurors; and amending RCW
2 2.36.150.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.36.150 and 1987 c 202 s 105 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 Jurors shall receive for each day's attendance, besides mileage at
7 the rate determined under RCW 43.03.060, ((the following))
8 compensation((:

9 (1) ~~Grand jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no~~
10 ~~case less than ten dollars;~~

11 (2) ~~Petit jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no~~
12 ~~case less than ten dollars;~~

13 (3) ~~Coroner's jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in~~
14 ~~no case less than ten dollars;~~

1 ~~(4) District court jurors may receive up to twenty five dollars but~~
2 ~~in no case less than ten dollars: PROVIDED, That))~~ at not less than
3 the state minimum wage. A person excused from jury service at his or
4 her own request shall be allowed not more than a per diem and such
5 mileage, if any, as to the court shall seem just and equitable under
6 all circumstances(~~(: PROVIDED FURTHER, That))~~). The state shall fully
7 reimburse the county in which trial is held for all jury fees and
8 witness fees related to criminal cases which result from incidents
9 occurring within an adult or juvenile correctional institution(~~(:~~
10 ~~PROVIDED FURTHER, That))~~). The compensation paid jurors shall be
11 determined by the county legislative authority and shall be uniformly
12 applied within the county.
