1 AN ACT Relating to compensation for jurors; and amending RCW
2 2.36.150.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 2.36.150 and 1987 c 202 s 105 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) Jurors not receiving compensation from their employers under
7 subsection (2) of this section shall receive for each day's attendance,
8 besides mileage at the rate determined under RCW 43.03.060, (~~the~~
9 ~~following~~) compensation(~~:~~

10 ~~(1) Grand jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no~~
11 ~~case less than ten dollars;~~

12 ~~(2) Petit jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in no~~
13 ~~case less than ten dollars;~~

14 ~~(3) Coroner's jurors may receive up to twenty-five dollars but in~~
15 ~~no case less than ten dollars;~~

1 ~~(4) District court jurors may receive up to twenty five dollars but~~
2 ~~in no case less than ten dollars: PROVIDED, That))~~ at not less than
3 the state minimum wage. A person excused from jury service at his or
4 her own request shall be allowed not more than a per diem and such
5 mileage, if any, as to the court shall seem just and equitable under
6 all circumstances(~~(: PROVIDED FURTHER, That))~~). The state shall fully
7 reimburse the county in which trial is held for all jury fees and
8 witness fees related to criminal cases which result from incidents
9 occurring within an adult or juvenile correctional institution(~~(:~~
10 ~~PROVIDED FURTHER, That))~~). The compensation paid jurors shall be
11 determined by the county legislative authority and shall be uniformly
12 applied within the county.

13 (2) Employers with ten or more employees shall continue to pay a
14 regular salary to full-time employees during their jury service.
