- 1 AN ACT Relating to agricultural nuisances; and amending RCW
- 2 7.48.305 and 7.48.310.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 7.48.305 and 1979 c 122 s 2 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, agricultural
- 7 activities conducted on farmland, if consistent with good agricultural
- 8 practices and established prior to surrounding nonagricultural
- 9 activities, are presumed to be reasonable and ((do)) shall not be found
- 10 to constitute a nuisance unless the activity has a substantial adverse
- 11 effect on the public health and safety.
- 12 If that agricultural activity is undertaken in conformity with
- 13 federal, state, and local laws and regulations, it is presumed to be
- 14 good agricultural practice and not adversely affecting the public

- 1 health and safety, and as such shall not be restricted to time of day,
- 2 or day or days of the week.
- 3 Sec. 2. RCW 7.48.310 and 1979 c 122 s 3 are each amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 As used in RCW 7.48.305:
- 6 (1) "Agricultural activity" means a condition or activity which
- 7 occurs on a farm in connection with the commercial production of farm
- 8 products and includes, but is not limited to, ((the growing or raising
- 9 of horticultural and viticultural crops, berries, poultry, livestock,
- 10 grain, mint, hay, and dairy products)) marketed produce at roadside
- 11 stands or farm markets; noise; odors; dust; fumes; operation of
- 12 machinery and irrigation pumps; movement, including, but not limited
- 13 to, use of current county road ditches, streams, rivers, canals, and
- 14 drains, and use of water for agricultural activities; ground and aerial
- 15 seeding and spraying; the application of chemical fertilizers,
- 16 conditioners, insecticides, pesticides, and herbicides and associated
- 17 drift of such materials; employment and use of labor; roadway movement
- 18 of equipment and livestock; protection from damage by wildlife;
- 19 prevention of trespass; construction and maintenance of buildings,
- 20 fences, roads, bridges, ponds, drains, waterways, and similar features
- 21 and maintenance of streambanks and watercourses; and conversion from
- 22 one agricultural activity to another.
- 23 (2) "Farm" means the land, buildings, and machinery used in the
- 24 commercial production of farm products.
- 25 (3) "Farmland" means land devoted primarily to the production, for
- 26 commercial purposes, of livestock or agricultural commodities.
- 27 (4) "Farm product" means those plants and animals useful to humans
- 28 and includes, but is not limited to, forages and sod crops, dairy and
- 29 dairy products, poultry and poultry products, livestock, including

- 1 breeding and grazing, fruits, vegetables, flowers, seeds, grasses,
- 2 trees, fish, apiaries, equine and other similar products, or any other
- 3 product which incorporates the use of food, feed, fiber, or fur.
