- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 75.10.010 and 1985 c 155 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) Fisheries patrol officers and ex officio fisheries patrol
- 7 officers within their respective jurisdictions, shall enforce this
- 8 title, rules of the director, and other statutes as prescribed by the
- 9 legislature.
- 10 (2) When acting within the scope of subsection (1) of this section
- 11 and when an offense occurs in the presence of the fisheries patrol
- 12 officer who is not an ex officio fisheries patrol officer, the
- 13 fisheries patrol officer may enforce all criminal laws of the state.
- 14 The fisheries patrol officer must have successfully completed the basic

- 1 law enforcement academy course sponsored by the criminal justice
- 2 training commission, or a supplemental course in criminal law
- 3 enforcement as approved by the department and the criminal justice
- 4 training commission and provided by the department or the criminal
- 5 justice training commission, prior to enforcing the criminal laws of
