- 1 AN ACT Relating to establishing preferences for in-state
- 2 contractors in contracts for public works and for public purchase of
- 3 goods; and adding a new chapter to Title 39 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Unless the context requires otherwise,
- 6 the definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter.
- 7 (1) "Department" means the department of general administration.
- 8 (2) "Public agency" means the state of Washington and all
- 9 departments, commissions, agencies, and political subdivisions of the
- 10 state as defined in RCW 39.04.010.
- 11 (3) "Public works" means all work as defined in RCW 39.04.010.
- 12 (4) "Nonresident bidder" means a bidder whose residence is not in
- 13 Washington, as determined in section 2 of this act.
- 14 (5) "Resident bidder" means a bidder whose residence is in
- 15 Washington, as determined in section 2 of this act.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** (1) For the purposes of this section,
- 2 the word "resident" shall include actual residence of an individual
- 3 within this state for a period of more than one year immediately prior
- 4 to bidding.
- 5 (2) In a partnership or an association, the majority of all
- 6 partners or association members shall have been actual residents of the
- 7 state of Washington for more than one year immediately prior to
- 8 bidding.
- 9 (3) Domestic corporations organized under the laws of the state of
- 10 Washington are prima facie eligible to bid as residents, but this
- 11 qualification may be set aside and a successful bid disallowed when it
- 12 is shown to the satisfaction of the board, commission, officer, or
- 13 individual charged with the responsibility for the execution of the
- 14 contract that the corporation is a wholly owned subsidiary of a foreign
- 15 corporation or that the corporation was formed for circumventing the
- 16 provisions relating to residence.
- 17 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. (1) To provide for an orderly
- 18 administration of the business of the state of Washington in awarding
- 19 public contracts for public works, a public agency shall award a public
- 20 works contract to the lowest responsible resident bidder whose bid does
- 21 not exceed ten percent over the lowest responsible nonresident bidder.
- 22 (2) The preference in this section applies:
- 23 (a) Whether the law requires advertisement for bids; and
- 24 (b) To contracts involving funds obtained from the federal
- 25 government unless expressly prohibited by the laws of the United States
- 26 or regulations enacted pursuant thereto.
- 27 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** (1) The department shall determine
- 28 whether certain contractors, registered under chapter 18.27 RCW, are

- 1 residents of the state of Washington within the meaning of sections 2
- 2 and 3 of this act. Any public agency charged by law with the
- 3 responsibility for the execution of any contract subject to the
- 4 provisions of section 3 of this act may request that a determination of
- 5 resident/nonresident status be made by the department. All requests
- 6 must specify the name and address of the registered public contractor
- 7 for whom a determination of resident/nonresident status is required.
- 8 (2) If a determination is made that a licensed public contractor is
- 9 not a resident but the contractor thereafter qualifies as a resident,
- 10 the contractor may apply to the department for a redetermination of
- 11 residency. If, upon redetermination, the registered public contractor
- 12 is found to qualify as a resident, the contractor shall be furnished a
- 13 letter by the department attesting to resident status.
- 14 (3) The determination of the department that a registered public
- 15 contractor is or is not a resident within the meaning of sections 2 and
- 16 3 of this act is prima facie evidence of that fact.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION</u>. **Sec. 5.** Public agencies may not show any
- 18 partiality or favoritism in making awards or contracts and must be
- 19 absolutely fair and impartial. If the bids offered are the same,
- 20 preference shall be given to resident bidders as defined in section 2
- 21 of this act over nonresident bidders.
- 22 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** The department shall adopt rules
- 23 necessary to administer this chapter. All public agencies are subject
- 24 to this chapter.
- 25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 7.** Sections 1 through 6 of this act shall
- 26 constitute a new chapter in Title 39 RCW.
