## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5228

- 1 AN ACT Relating to reducing legislative per diem and appropriations
- 2 to the governor as an incentive for concluding extraordinary sessions
- 3 of the legislature; adding a new section to chapter 43.88 RCW; and
- 4 declaring an emergency.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.88 RCW
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (1) For each day after the first ten days of an extraordinary
- 9 session of the legislature pursuant to Article II, section 12(2) of the
- 10 state Constitution, one percent shall be deducted from the monthly
- 11 salary of all employees of the governor's office and of the executive
- 12 policy division of the office of financial management or its successor
- 13 agency, and the director of financial management shall remove from
- 14 appropriated status an equivalent amount of the state general funds

- 1 appropriated for the operation of the office of the governor and for
- 2 the operation of the office of financial management.
- 3 (2) The funds removed from appropriated status under this section,
- 4 together with the moneys identified in RCW 44.04.120(2), shall be
- 5 deposited in the state conservancy account hereby created in the state
- 6 treasury. Moneys in the account may be appropriated by the legislature
- 7 solely for the purpose of acquiring or improving lands for wildlife
- 8 habitat, conservation, or public recreation purposes.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 10 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 11 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 12 effect immediately.
