## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5237

- AN ACT Relating to proper lane travel; and amending RCW 46.61.100. 1
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 3 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.100 and 1986 c 93 s 2 are each amended to read
- 4 as follows:
- 5 (1) Upon all roadways of sufficient width a vehicle shall be driven
- 6 upon the right half of the roadway, except as follows:
- 7 (a) When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the
- same direction under the rules governing such movement; 8
- 9 (b) When an obstruction exists making it necessary to drive to the
- 10 left of the center of the highway; provided, any person so doing shall
- 11 yield the right of way to all vehicles traveling in the proper
- direction upon the unobstructed portion of the highway within such 12
- distance as to constitute an immediate hazard; 13
- 14 (c) Upon a roadway divided into three marked lanes and providing
- 15 for two-way movement traffic under the rules applicable thereon; or

- 1 (d) Upon a street or highway restricted to one-way traffic.
- 2 (2) Upon all roadways having two or more lanes for traffic moving
- 3 in the same direction, all vehicles shall be driven in the right-hand
- 4 lane then available for traffic, except (a) when overtaking and passing
- 5 another vehicle proceeding in the same direction, (b) ((when traveling
- 6 at a speed greater than the traffic flow, (c))) when moving left to
- 7 allow traffic to merge, or  $((\frac{d}{d}))$  (c) when preparing for a left turn
- 8 at an intersection, exit, or into a private road or driveway when such
- 9 left turn is legally permitted. On any such roadway, a motor ((truck))
- 10 vehicle with a licensed gross weight of ten thousand pounds or more
- 11 shall be driven only in the right-hand lane except under the conditions
- 12 enumerated in (a) through  $((\frac{d}{d}))$  (c) of this subsection.
- 13 (3) <u>Upon any fully controlled limited access facility having three</u>
- 14 or more lanes for traffic moving in the same direction, no motor
- 15 <u>vehicle with a licensed gross weight of twenty-six thousand pounds or</u>
- 16 more may be driven in the left lane, except as provided in subsection
- 17 (2)(c) of this section. This provision does not restrict a qualifying
- 18 vehicle from using the left lane when that lane is a high occupancy
- 19 vehicle lane.
- 20 (4) It is a traffic infraction to drive continuously in the left
- 21 lane of a multilane roadway when it impedes the flow of other traffic.
- $((\frac{4}{1}))$  (5) Upon any roadway having four or more lanes for moving
- 23 traffic and providing for two-way movement of traffic, a vehicle shall
- 24 not be driven to the left of the center line of the roadway except when
- 25 authorized by official traffic control devices designating certain
- 26 lanes to the left side of the center of the roadway for use by traffic
- 27 not otherwise permitted to use such lanes, or except as permitted under
- 28 subsection (1)(b) of this section. However, this subsection shall not
- 29 be construed as prohibiting the crossing of the center line in making
- 30 a left turn into or from an alley, private road or driveway.
