1 AN ACT Relating to security in schools; and making an
2 appropriation.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The sum of three million three hundred
5 thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is
6 appropriated for the biennium ending June 30, 1993, from the drug
7 enforcement and education account to the superintendent of public
8 instruction for matching grants to enhance security in secondary
9 schools. School districts that apply for such grants shall ensure that
10 no more than seventy-five percent of the district's total expenditures
11 for school security in any school year are supported by the grant
12 amounts. The grants shall be expended solely for the costs of
13 employing or contracting for building security monitors in middle and
14 secondary schools during school hours and school events, including the
15 costs of equipment and supplies involved in the employment or contract.

1 Of the amount appropriated in this section, a minimum of two million
2 seven hundred fifty thousand dollars is provided for grants to
3 districts that, during the 1988-89 school year, employed or contracted
4 for security monitors in schools during school hours.
