## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5269

- 1 AN ACT Relating to waste disposal permits for fin fish rearing
- 2 projects; and amending RCW 90.48.160.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 90.48.160 and 1989 c 293 s 2 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 Any person who conducts a commercial or industrial operation of any
- 7 type which results in the disposal of solid or liquid waste material
- 8 into the waters of the state, including commercial or industrial
- 9 operators discharging solid or liquid waste material into sewerage
- 10 systems operated by municipalities or public entities which discharge
- 11 into public waters of the state, shall procure a permit from either the
- 12 department or the ((thermal power plant)) energy facility site
- 13 evaluation council as provided in RCW 90.48.262(2) before disposing of
- 14 such waste material: PROVIDED, That this section shall not apply to any
- 15 person discharging domestic sewage only into a sewerage system.

- 1 The department may, through the adoption of rules, eliminate the
- 2 permit requirements for disposing of wastes into publicly operated
- 3 sewerage systems for:
- 4 (1) Categories of or individual municipalities or public
- 5 corporations operating sewerage systems; or
- 6 (2) Any category of waste disposer;
- 7 if the department determines such permit requirements are no longer
- 8 necessary for the effective implementation of this chapter. The
- 9 department ((may by rule)) shall eliminate the permit requirements for
- 10 disposing of wastes by ((upland)) fin fish rearing facilities unless a
- 11 permit is required under the federal clean water act's national
- 12 pollutant discharge elimination system.
- 13 The department shall eliminate the requirements for waste disposal
- 14 permits for cooperative aquaculture fin fish net pens authorized under
- 15 chapter 75.52 RCW that produce less than twenty thousand pounds of fin
- 16 fish annually for release into state waters and are intended to
- 17 <u>increase public fisheries</u>.
