- (iii) The objectives of the project are to consider revisions that $\mbox{will:}$
- (A) Require preplanning studies for major projects to determine project scope, cost, and alternatives;
- (B) Require detailed cost and timeline data for each capital request;
- (C) Require analysis by the superintendent of public instruction staff of cost, timelines, and alternatives of all projects;
- (D) Require approval by the state board of education of all capital projects;
- (E) Require a method of monitoring the actual costs and timelines of projects in comparison to those approved;
- (F) Establish in statute, criteria for funding modernization projects; and
- (G) Establish standards and require evaluation and monitoring of annual maintenance cost by local districts.
- (iv) The completed project and recommended legislation shall be presented to the legislature and the governor by December 1, 1991.
- (v) The revised funding process shall be implemented by June 30, 1992.

The office of the superintendent of 28

1 public instruction shall coordinate the use of video telecommunications

2 in public schools by providing educational information to local school

3 districts and shall assist local school districts and educational

4 service districts in telecommunications planning and curriculum

5 development. Before any such expenditure by a public institution of

6 postsecondary education, a telecommunications expenditure plan shall be

7 approved by the higher education coordinating board. The higher

8 education coordinating board shall coordinate the use of video

9 telecommunications for instruction and instructional support in

10 postsecondary education, including the review and approval of

11 instructional telecommunications course offerings.

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 55.** To ensure that major construction projects 13 are carried out in accordance with legislative and executive intent, capital projects for renovation or additional space contained in this 14 15 act that exceed two million five hundred thousand dollars for which a 16 program document is not completed before September 1, 1990, shall not 17 expend funds for planning and construction until the office of 18 financial management has reviewed the agency's programmatic document 19 and approved continuation of the project. The program document shall include but not be limited to projected workload, site conditions, user 20 requirements, current space available, and an overall budget and cost 21 22 estimate breakdown in a form prescribed by the office of financial 23 management.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 56. The appropriations contained in this act

25 are maximum expenditure authorizations. Pursuant to RCW 43.88.037,

26 moneys disbursed from the treasury on the basis of a formalized loan

27 are to be recorded as loans receivable and not as expenditures for

- 1 accounting purposes. To the extent that moneys are disbursed on a loan
- 2 basis, the corresponding appropriation shall be reduced by the amount
- 3 of loan moneys disbursed from the treasury during the 1991-93 biennium.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 57.** If any provision of this act or its
- 5 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the

- 8 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 58.** This act is necessary for the immediate
