- 1 AN ACT Relating to employees using video display terminals; and
- 2 amending RCW 49.17.050.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 49.17.050 and 1973 c 80 s 5 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 In the adoption of rules and regulations under the authority of
- 7 this chapter, the director shall:
- 8 (1) Provide for the preparation, adoption, amendment, or repeal of
- 9 rules and regulations of safety and health standards governing the
- 10 conditions of employment of general and special application in all work
- 11 places;
- 12 (2) Provide for the adoption of occupational health and safety
- 13 standards which are at least as effective as those adopted or
- 14 recognized by the United States secretary of labor under the authority

- 1 of the Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-596;
- 2 84 Stat. 1590);
- 3 (3) Provide a method of encouraging employers and employees in
- 4 their efforts to reduce the number of safety and health hazards at
- 5 their work places and to stimulate employers and employees to institute
- 6 new and to perfect existing programs for providing safe and healthful
- 7 working conditions;
- 8 (4) Provide for the promulgation of health and safety standards and
- 9 the control of conditions in all work places concerning gases, vapors,
- 10 dust, or other airborne particles, toxic materials, or harmful physical
- 11 agents which shall set a standard which most adequately assures, to the
- 12 extent feasible, on the basis of the best available evidence, that no
- 13 employee will suffer material impairment of health or functional
- 14 capacity even if such employee has regular exposure to the hazard dealt
- 15 with by such standard for the period of his or her working life; any
- 16 such standards shall require where appropriate the use of protective
- 17 devices or equipment and for monitoring or measuring any such gases,
- 18 vapors, dust, or other airborne particles, toxic materials, or harmful
- 19 physical agents;
- 20 (5) Provide for appropriate reporting procedures by employers with
- 21 respect to such information relating to conditions of employment which
- 22 will assist in achieving the objectives of this chapter;
- 23 (6) Provide for the frequency, method, and manner of the making of
- 24 inspections of work places without advance notice; ((and,))
- 25 (7) Provide for the publication and dissemination to employers,
- 26 employees, and labor organizations and the posting where appropriate by
- 27 employers of informational, education, or training materials calculated
- 28 to aid and assist in achieving the objectives of this chapter;
- 29 (8) Provide for the establishment of new and the perfection and
- 30 expansion of existing programs for occupational safety and health

- 1 education for employers and employees, and, in addition institute
- 2 methods and procedures for the establishment of a program for voluntary
- 3 compliance solely through the use of advice and consultation with
- 4 employers and employees with recommendations including recommendations
- 5 of methods to abate violations relating to the requirements of this
- 6 chapter and all applicable safety and health standards and rules and
- 7 regulations promulgated pursuant to the authority of this chapter;
- 8 (9) Provide for the adoption of safety and health standards
- 9 requiring the use of safeguards in trenches and excavations and around
- 10 openings of hoistways, hatchways, elevators, stairways, and similar
- 11 openings;
- 12 (10) Provide for the promulgation of health and safety standards
- 13 requiring the use of safeguards for all vats, pans, trimmers, cut off,
- 14 gang edger, and other saws, planers, presses, formers, cogs, gearing,
- 15 belting, shafting, coupling, set screws, live rollers, conveyors,
- 16 mangles in laundries, and machinery of similar description, which can
- 17 be effectively guarded with due regard to the ordinary use of such
- 18 machinery and appliances and the danger to employees therefrom, and
- 19 with which the employees of any such work place may come in contact
- 20 while in the performance of their duties and prescribe methods,
- 21 practices, or processes to be followed by employers which will enhance
- 22 the health and safety of employees in the performance of their duties
- 23 when in proximity to machinery or appliances mentioned in this
- 24 subsection;
- 25 (11) Provide for the promulgation of health and safety standards
- 26 requiring the use of safeguards and practices to be followed by
- 27 employers which will enhance the health and safety of employees using
- 28 <u>video display terminals</u>.
