## SENATE BILL 5543

State of Washington 52nd Legislature 1991 Regular Session

Read first time February 6, 1991. Referred to Committee on Education.

- 1 AN ACT Relating to the professional standards unit within the
- 2 office of the superintendent of public instruction; adding a new
- 3 section to chapter 28A.300 RCW; and making an appropriation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28A.300
- 6 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The superintendent of public instruction shall establish a
- 8 professional standards unit to receive, investigate, and process
- 9 written complaints or reports of lack of good moral character and
- 10 personal fitness and acts of unprofessional conduct by school staff,
- 11 including reports or complaints of suspected acts of child abuse and
- 12 neglect by school staff on school grounds or in school facilities.

- 1 The professional standards unit, under the authority of the
- 2 superintendent of public instruction, shall also enforce the code of
- 3 professional conduct adopted by rule by the state board of education.
- 4 (2) Any person may submit a written report or complaint to the
- 5 superintendent of public instruction. The professional standards unit
- 6 shall investigate all written reports and complaints.
- 7 (3) The superintendent of public instruction may, upon the findings
- 8 of an investigation, and when appropriate, prepare cases for formal
- 9 action by the attorney general of Washington state.
- 10 (4) The superintendent of public instruction may establish a panel
- 11 of educators to review cases prepared by the professional standards
- 12 unit. The panel may review cases and make recommendations to the
- 13 superintendent of public instruction regarding actions only in those
- 14 instances when a formal hearing has been held by the professional
- 15 standards unit.
- 16 The superintendent of public instruction or his or her designee is
- 17 responsible for making the final determination regarding potential
- 18 actions, including but not limited to: Recommendation for suspension,
- 19 letter of reprimand, certificate revocation, or request for legal
- 20 action by the attorney general.
- 21 (5) The professional standards unit may work with the department of
- 22 social and health services or law enforcement agencies in conducting
- 23 investigations.
- 24 (6) The superintendent of public instruction shall report annually
- 25 to the legislature on the number of written reports and complaints
- 26 received and the resolution of those complaints. The report shall
- 27 include a breakdown indicating the number of reports received by
- 28 parents, students, teachers, administrators, other school personnel,
- 29 and others.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** The sum of five hundred sixty thousand
- 2 dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for
- 3 the biennium ending June 30, 1993, from the general fund to the
- 4 superintendent of public instruction for the purpose of section 1 of
- 5 this act.
