- 1 AN ACT Relating to liability of handlers of low-level radioactive
- 2 waste; and amending RCW 43.200.210 and 70.98.095.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 43.200.210 and 1990 c 82 s 2 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 (1)(a) The department of ecology shall require that any person who
- 7 holds or applies for a permit under this chapter indemnify and hold
- 8 harmless the state from claims, suits, damages, or expenses on account
- 9 of injuries to or death of persons and property, arising or growing out
- 10 of any acts or omissions of the person or the person's agents or
- 11 employees in any operations and activities for which the person holds
- 12 the ((<del>license or</del>)) permit, and any necessary or incidental operations.
- 13 (b) Except for a permit holder not required to maintain liability
- 14 insurance coverage under RCW 43.200.200(7), the department shall
- 15 require any person who holds or applies for a permit under this chapter

- 1 to demonstrate that the person has and maintains liability coverage for
- 2 the operations for which the state has been indemnified and held
- 3 harmless pursuant to this section. The agency shall require coverage
- 4 in an amount determined by the director of the department of ecology
- 5 pursuant to RCW 43.200.200.
- 6 (2) The department of ecology shall suspend the ((license)) permit
- 7 of, or refuse to issue the permit to, any person required by this
- 8 section to indemnify and hold harmless the state under subsection
- 9 (1)(a) of this section, or to hold and maintain liability coverage
- 10 under subsection (1)(b) of this section, who fails to ((demonstrate
- 11 compliance)) comply with either requirement of subsection (1) of this
- 12 section. The permit shall not be <u>issued or</u> reinstated until the person
- 13 ((demonstrates compliance)) complies with subsection (1) of this
- 14 section.
- 15 (3) The department of ecology shall require (a) that any person
- 16 required to maintain liability coverage maintain with the agency
- 17 current copies of any insurance policies, certificates of insurance, or
- 18 any other documents used to comply with this section, (b) that the
- 19 agency be notified of any changes in the insurance coverage or
- 20 financial condition of the person, and (c) that the state be named as
- 21 an insured party on any insurance policy used to comply with this
- 22 section.
- 23 Sec. 2. RCW 70.98.095 and 1990 c 82 s 4 are each amended to read
- 24 as follows:
- 25 (1)(a) The radiation control agency shall require that any person
- 26 who holds or applies for a license or permit under this chapter
- 27 indemnify and hold harmless the state from claims, suits, damages, or
- 28 expenses on account of injuries to or death of persons and property,
- 29 arising or growing out of any acts or omissions by the person or the

- 1 person's agents or employees in any operations or activities for which
- 2 the person holds the license or permit, and any necessary or incidental
- 3 operations.
- 4 (b) Except for a license or permit holder who the secretary has
- 5 exempted from maintaining liability coverage pursuant to RCW
- 6 70.98.098(5), the radiation control agency shall require any person who
- 7 holds or applies for a license or permit under this chapter to
- 8 demonstrate that the person has and maintains liability coverage for
- 9 the operations for which the state has been indemnified and held
- 10 harmless pursuant to this section. The agency shall require coverage
- 11 in an amount determined by the secretary pursuant to RCW 70.98.098.
- 12 (2) The radiation control agency shall suspend the license or
- 13 permit of, or refuse to issue the license or permit to, any person
- 14 required by this section to indemnify and hold harmless the state under
- 15 <u>subsection (1)(a) of this section, or to hold and maintain liability</u>
- 16 coverage <u>under subsection (1)(b) of this section</u>, who fails to
- 17 ((demonstrate compliance)) comply with either requirement of subsection
- 18 (1) of this section. The license or permit shall not be <u>issued or</u>
- 19 reinstated until the person ((demonstrates compliance)) complies with
- 20 <u>subsection (1) of</u> this section.
- 21 (3) The radiation control agency shall require (a) that any person
- 22 required to maintain liability coverage maintain with the agency
- 23 current copies of any insurance policies, certificates of insurance, or
- 24 any other documents used to comply with this section, (b) that the
