- 1 AN ACT Relating to unfair discrimination in insurance based upon
- 2 choice of health care practitioner; amending RCW 48.30.300; and
- 3 declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 48.30.300 and 1975-'76 2nd ex.s. c 119 s 7 are each
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 No person or entity engaged in the business of insurance in this
- 8 state shall refuse to issue any contract of insurance or cancel or
- 9 decline to renew such contract because of the sex ((or)), marital
- 10 status, or choice of health care provider, or the presence of any
- 11 sensory, mental, or physical handicap of the insured or prospective
- 12 insured. The amount of benefits payable, or any term, rate, condition,
- 13 or type of coverage shall not be restricted, modified, excluded,
- 14 increased or reduced on the basis of the sex ((or)), marital status, or
- 15 <u>choice of health care provider</u>, or be restricted, modified, excluded,

- 1 or reduced on the basis of the presence of any sensory, mental, or
- 2 physical handicap of the insured or prospective insured. These
- 3 provisions shall not prohibit fair discrimination on the basis of sex,
- 4 ((or)) marital status, or choice of health care provider, or the
- 5 presence of any sensory, mental, or physical handicap, when bona fide
- 6 statistical differences in risk or exposure have been substantiated.
- 7 For purposes of this section, "health care provider" means those health
- 8 professions specified in RCW 18.120.020(4) except embalmers and funeral
- 9 directors under chapter 18.39 RCW, veterinarians and animal technicians
- 10 under chapter 18.92 RCW, and persons registered or certified under
- 11 <u>chapter 18.19 RCW.</u>
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 13 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 14 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 15 effect immediately.
