- 1 AN ACT Relating to the automated client eligibility system;
- 2 creating a new section; and declaring an emergency.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Expenditures by the department of social
- 5 and health services for the automated client eligibility system (ACES)
- 6 during the 1989-91 fiscal biennium and subsequent biennia shall comply
- 7 with the following conditions and limitations:
- 8 (1) All planning and implementation of ACES shall comply in full
- 9 with section 802, chapter 19, Laws of 1989 1st ex. sess. All reports
- 10 required under section 802, chapter 19, Laws of 1989 1st ex. sess.
- 11 shall be submitted to the senate committee on ways and means and the
- 12 house of representatives committee on appropriations;
- 13 (2) A maximum of \$..... of general fund--state moneys may be
- 14 expended on ACES during the 1991-93 fiscal biennium;

- 1 (3) The request for proposals for phase III of the ACES project,
- 2 and any contract entered thereunder, shall clearly specify that the
- 3 state shall not accept or pay for the ACES system until accepted and
- 4 proven operable by the field staff of the department of social and
- 5 health services, including liquidated damages where appropriate; and
- 6 (4) All monthly and quarterly status reports required under chapter
- 7 VI of the November 1990 ACES advanced planning document shall be
- 8 submitted to the senate committee on ways and means and the house of
- 9 representatives committee on appropriations.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 11 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 12 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 13 effect immediately.
