- 1 AN ACT Relating to the study of ethanol for supplemental energy
- 2 production; and adding a new section to chapter 43.21F RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.21F RCW
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The office shall act as the state clearinghouse for information
- 7 regarding the production and use of ethanol and other synthetic fuels
- 8 within the state, and shall:
- 9 (a) Collect and disseminate information regarding the production
- 10 and use of ethanol and other synthetic fuels;
- 11 (b) Monitor the results of pilot programs nation-wide on the use of
- 12 ethanol and other synthetic fuels as automotive fuels;
- 13 (c) Advise, consult, and cooperate with other agencies of the
- 14 state, the federal government, other states and interstate agencies,

- 1 political subdivisions, and with groups concerned with use of ethanol
- 2 and other synthetic fuels;
- 3 (d) Consult regularly with the state department of agriculture on
- 4 the feasibility, quantity, and quality of production of organic
- 5 feedstocks used in producing ethanol, and methods of encouraging or
- 6 facilitating such production; and
- 7 (e) Assist in planning, implementing, and evaluating pilot projects
- 8 for the use of ethanol within the state.
- 9 (2) The office shall, in its biennial report to the governor and
- 10 legislature required under RCW 43.21F.045, include summaries of the
- 11 status of, and any recommendations as to the increased production and
- 12 use of, ethanol and synthetic fuels in the state, including the need
- 13 for any separate entity to develop additional information, coordinate
- 14 programs, or assist in the production of such fuels.
