- AN ACT Relating to representation on the redistricting commission;
- 2 and amending RCW 44.05.030.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 44.05.030 and 1984 c 13 s 1 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 A redistricting commission shall be established in January of each
- 7 year ending in one to accomplish state legislative and congressional
- 8 redistricting. The five-member commission shall be appointed as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) Each legislative leader of the two largest political parties in
- 11 each house of the legislature shall appoint one voting member to the
- 12 commission by January 15th of each year ending in one.
- 13 (2) The four legislators appointing commission members pursuant to
- 14 this section shall certify their appointments to the chief election
- 15 officer. If an appointing legislator does not certify an appointment

- 1 by January 15th of each year ending in one, within five days the
- 2 supreme court shall certify an appointment to the chief election
- 3 officer.
- 4 (3) No later than January 31st of the year of their selection, the
- 5 four appointed members, by an affirmative vote of at least three, shall
- 6 appoint and certify to the chief election officer the nonvoting fifth
- 7 member who shall act as the commission's chairperson. At least two
- 8 members of the commission shall reside east of the crest of the Cascade
- 9 mountain range. If by January 31st of the year of their selection
- 10 three of the four voting members fail to elect a chairperson, the
- 11 supreme court shall within five days certify an appointment to the
- 12 chief election officer. A vacancy on the commission shall be filled by
- 13 the person who made the initial appointment, or their successor, within
- 14 fifteen days after the vacancy occurs.
