- 1 AN ACT Relating to the cessation of operations of the Bothell-
- 2 Woodinville branch campus of the University of Washington; adding new
- 3 sections to chapter 28B.45 RCW; and declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 28B.45 RCW
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The University of Washington shall suspend all operations of the
- 8 branch campus located in the Bothell-Woodinville area. The University
- 9 of Washington shall cease all operating and capital activities of the
- 10 Bothell-Woodinville branch campus until the legislature receives the
- 11 report required by section 2 of this act and takes specific action to
- 12 resume such activities. The University of Washington is hereby
- 13 directed to cease all operations and all activities toward site
- 14 acquisition, facilities acquisition, and capital construction for the
- 15 Bothell-Woodinville branch campus.

- 1 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.45 RCW
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 The University of Washington, in coordination with the higher
- 4 education coordinating board, shall report to the legislature by
- 5 January 1, 1997, with plans, procedures, and recommendations for
- 6 resuming the operations of the Bothell-Woodinville branch campus. Upon
- 7 positive recommendation by the higher education coordinating board and
- 8 the University of Washington, the legislature may take action to resume
- 9 operating and capital activities at the Bothell-Woodinville branch
- 10 campus.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.45 RCW
- 12 to read as follows:
- 13 The University of Washington is directed to accept into its main
- 14 campus programs all students of the Bothell-Woodinville branch campus
- 15 displaced by the cessation of the branch campus operations pursuant to
- 16 section 1 of this act.
- 17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 18 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 19 state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take
- 20 effect immediately.
- 21 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** If any provision of this act or its
- 22 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the
- 23 remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other
- 24 persons or circumstances is not affected.
