- 2 18.71A.060.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 18.71A.060 and 1990 c 196 s 6 are each amended to read
- 5 as follows:
- 6 No health care services may be performed under this chapter in any
- 7 of the following areas:
- 8 (1) The measurement of the powers or range of human vision, or the
- 9 determination of the accommodation and refractive state of the human
- 10 eye or the scope of its functions in general, or the fitting or
- 11 adaptation of lenses or frames for the aid thereof.
- 12 (2) The prescribing or directing the use of, or using, any optical
- 13 device in connection with ocular exercises, visual training, vision
- 14 training or orthoptics.

- 1 (3) The prescribing of contact lenses for, or the fitting or
- 2 adaptation of contact lenses to, the human eye.
- 3 (4) Nothing in this section shall preclude the performance of
- 4 routine visual screening.
- 5 (5) The practice of dentistry or dental hygiene as defined in
- 6 chapters 18.32 and 18.29 RCW respectively. The exemptions set forth in
- 7 RCW 18.32.030, paragraphs (1) and (8), shall not apply to a physician
- 8 assistant.
- 9 (6) The practice of chiropractic as defined in chapter 18.25 RCW
- 10 including the adjustment or manipulation of the articulations of the
- 11 spine.
- 12 ((<del>(7)</del> The practice of podiatry as defined in chapter 18.22 RCW.))
